1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 ABSTRACT

The aim of this document is to describe the format of the language file containing language sensitive texts and characters that are used for the DBC 422 02 and DBC 425 02.

Note that this document does not cover the texts displayed when booting the telephone. Also note that some texts may be sent from the GK

This document is intended for system administrators that want to change text strings shown in the telephone display, but also for translators making localization of files.

DESCRIPTION

2.1

FILE SYNTAX

The file contains all languages supported by the DBC 42x 02.

The file should be stored in the directory defined in the Config file, usually /dbc42x02 directory of the HTTP server.

The file shall be saved in 16 bit UNICODE file format, this can be done in Microsoft Word.

The file consists of the following parts and the syntax should be:

CHANGE OF A TEXT STRING SHOWN IN THE DISPLAY

Sometimes there is a need to change a text string shown in the display in the telephone. An example is when the used word for an absence reason, in the **Absence** menu, shall be adapted to what is used in the PABX. The system administrator can change the text string in the following way:

1. Use Microsoft Word to edit the language file.
2. Find the word to edit. If it is an absence reason word, see 2.9 [MAIN_TEXTS] on page 10, strings T155-T168.
3. Edit the word in the specific language that shall be changed.
4. Store the edited language file on the software server. Use a different revision in the file name; if the original file was called d42x02-lang_r1a.txt call the edited file d42x02-lang_r1a1.txt
5. Change the revision of the language file in the configuration file.
6. Reboot the telephone, either by command from the gatekeeper or manually.

Note: No word can be removed or added. The only modification that is working is to change an existing word.

2.3 [LANGUAGE]

Language data such as two letter abbreviation for the available languages, revision, date and document number.

2.4 [LANGUAGE_NAMES]

Names of the available languages. The size of the text is 8 Reg. The maximum length in number of characters is 25 and the maximum length in number of pixels is 140.
