Enter a word or a phrase to search for:

Note: If you use Adobe Reader later than version 7, and face issues using the search function, see the following step-by-step-instruction below. Set **CPI Library** as **Privileged Locations** before you proceed.

1. Open Adobe Reader or the Library Search PDF file.
2. Click **Edit** and select **Preferences (Ctrl + K)**.
3. In the **Categories** list on the left, select **Security (Enhanced)**.
4. In the **Privileged Locations** square box, click **Add Folder Path** and select the folder contents for example (c:\user\desktop\ EN/LZN 748 0016\3 R1A) and click **Add File** and select **Library Search** file.
5. In the **Library Search** PDF file, enter a word or a phrase in the blank box. Select the **Case Sensitive** check box if you want the search to be case-sensitive.
6. Click **Go**. An **Arrange Windows** Search window opens.
7. Choose **All PDF Documents in**. By default, the **My Documents** folder displays in the drop-down list.
8. From the drop-down list, select the **Browse for Location**. The **Browse For Folder** option is displayed.
9. Navigate to the Alex downloaded zip folder that you have stored in your PC (for example, C:\Users\xxxx\xxxx\MX-ONE_6.3SP5_CPI_xxxx). Click **OK**.
10. Click **Search**. A **Security Warning** pop up window opens.
11. Click **Allow** to view the search results.
